And without realising the children will be gaining knowledge about the living environment around them. Building in confidence, developing leadership skills and developing friendships that will last a life time.



Important information

For us to be able to offer this opportunity we have to have a higher ratio, for our children the resources are also important. So to be able to offer this unique experiences of learning we need to ask that every time your child attends an **additional £15 per day** will be asked for in Addition to your children funding.

The children will have opportunity to:

- Build Dens, Construct obstacles.
- Use flint and steel to make fires, Fire safety, Cooking on fires,
- Problem solving, resolving conflict, developing self help skills, Independence in readiness for school.
- Phonics, mark making, looking at books area, Wild life area, construction.
- Just to name a few.



what you will need

CLOTHING:

A pair of thick socks X1

A change of clothes including pants and socks, it is important to layer up better to take layers off than be too cold. (**vest, long sleeve top, fleece, warm coat. Warm trousers, warm socks.**

A long sleeve flees, jumper X1

A pair of warm trousers X1

A pair of gloves 🧤 scarf 🧣 warm hat / sun hat .

A warm waterproof coat and water proof bottoms

Sun cream from April to November.

A pair of slipper / indoor shoes

A water bottle

Wellington boots and one rucksack 🎒 to fit everything in and a Wellington boot bag for when they are dirty.

Please note we do have ten pairs of fleece waterproof dungarees available to use.

We ask that you make sure that their name is on their clothing and personal possessions. As it's very difficult to remember who has

0	Calm	0-1	Smoke rises	Low

4	Moderate breeze	13-18	"Leaves and small branches sway"	Low
5	Fresh breeze	18-24	Small trees sway	Low
6	Strong breeze	25-31	"Large branches sway"	Low
7	Moderate gale	32-38	"Whole trees in motion"	Low
8	Fresh gale	39-46	Twigs break off trees	Low

As you can see from the above please dress your child for the weather, better to have more layers we can take off than not enough and be cold. We will be outside every day.

The only time we may have to cancel the woodland would be if the wind is too high and dangerous.
